## Enrollment Trends

## \# Enrolled: Fall 1969-2010



- Enrollment decreased sharply after 1980 and has fluctuated and been on a slight increase since 2006


## Enrollment Trends



- The age groups under 20, 20-24, 25-34 and 35+ have increased since 2006

- The number of Blacks at WLAC has slightly declined while the Hispanic group has increased significantly

- Since 1980, females are the largest proportion of students at WLAC

\% Enrolled by Home Language: Fall 1993-2010


- Since 1993, English speakers are the largest proportion of students

## \# Enrolled by Educational Attainment: Fall 1990-2010



- The number of U.S. high school graduates at WLAC has fluctuated since 1990 while the other groups have relatively remained the same

- The number of students who expressed interest in transferring has increased since 2005

## \# of Transfer Students to a UC or CSU: 1981-2010



- Since 1981, more students transfer to a CSU than a UC


## Transfers

\# of Transfer Students to CSU by Ethnicity: 2000-2009


- The majority of students who transfer to a CSU are Black


## Transfers

\# of Transfer Students to UC by Ethnicity: 2000-2009


- Between 2000 to 2004, the majority of students who transfer to a UC were Black; from 2005 to 2009, the majority were Hispanic
