

Enrollment Trends


Enrolled: Fall 1969 - 2010




Enrollment decreased sharply after 1980 and has fluctuated and been on a slight increase since 2006

 The age groups under 20, 20-24, 25-34 and 35+ have increased since 2006




% Enrolled by Citizenship: Fall 1995 - 2010

% Enrolled by Ethnicity: Fall 1972 - 2010




 The number of Blacks at WLAC has slightly declined while the Hispanic group has increased significantly

% Enrolled by Home Language: Fall 1993 - 2010




Since 1993, English speakers are the largest proportion of students


 The number of U.S. high school graduates at WLAC has fluctuated since 1990 while the other groups have relatively remained the same ¹⁰

Enrolled by Educational Goal: Fall 1983 - 2010




 The number of students who expressed interest in transferring has increased since 2005

of Transfer Students to a UC or CSU: 1981 - 2010




Since 1981, more students transfer to a CSU than a UC

The majority of students who transfer to a CSU are Black


of Transfer Students to UC by Ethnicity: 2000 - 2009


Financial Aid
